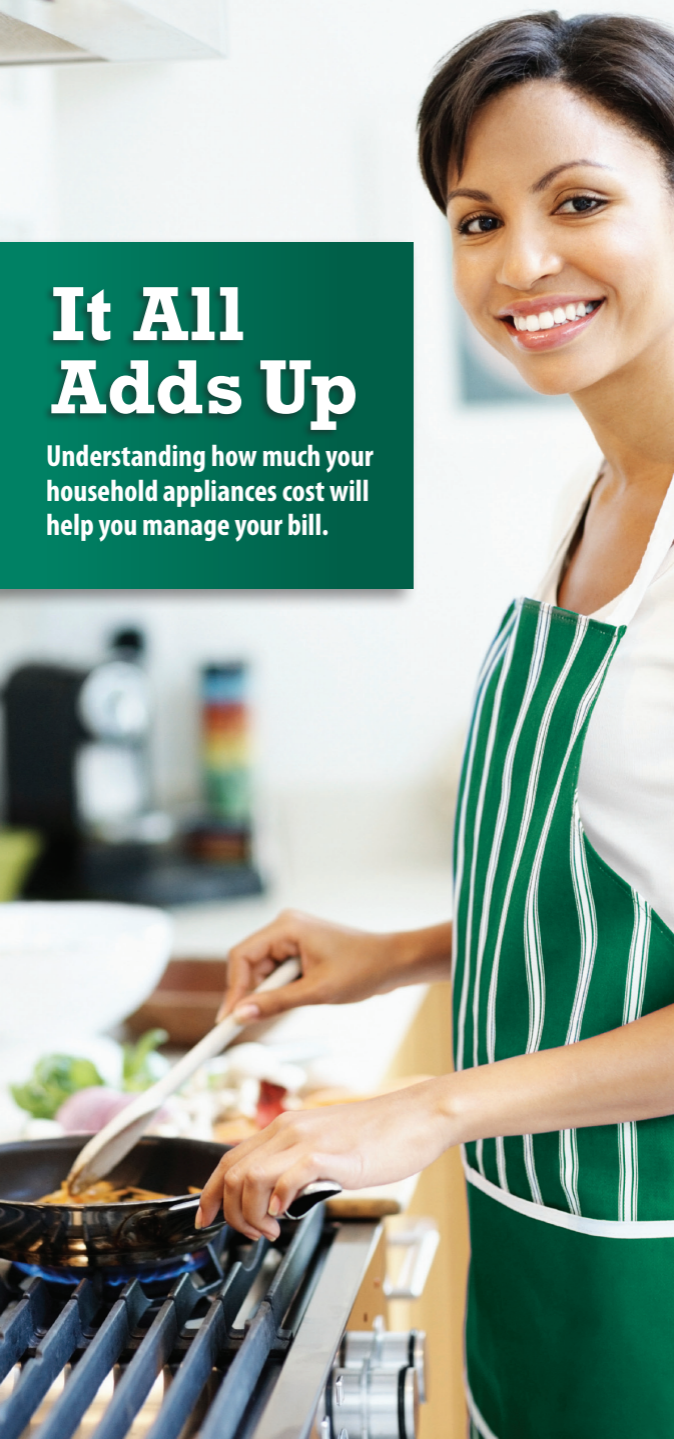


It All Adds Up
