ElectriCities Training - Duty of Care

The safety of those attending ElectriCities of North Carolina, Inc. (ElectriCities) 2022 Training courses is a priority. In response to COVID-19, attendees must agree to the following requirements prior to attending an ElectriCities training course.

Before Leaving Home

- Attendees must follow relevant guidance provided by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and any additional precautions outlined by their local health authority.
- Attendees must adhere to government-issued travel guidance and all applicable restrictions issued by the authorities in the region to which you are traveling and from which you are traveling.
- Attendees must STAY HOME if they feel ill, actively experience COVID-19 symptoms, or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive or presumed to be positive within 5 days prior to the training course start date.

On-Site During the Course

All attendees will abide by state and local ordinances and the host location policies related to COVID-19 prevention.

- If an attendee begins to actively experience COVID-19 symptoms during the training course they should self-quarantine immediately and notify ElectriCities staff.
- Any unvaccinated attendee must wear a face mask for the duration of the training course. This includes attendees that have not received their full vaccination series.

Personal Accountability Commitment

By registering for and attending an ElectriCities training course, you agree to abide by, and engage in, the outlined health-and-safety conduct while attending the event. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Adhering to all Duty of Care Attendee Requirements outlined above.
- Following state and local ordinances and host location policies related to COVID-19 prevention and preventative measures.
- Engaging in appropriate physical distancing and hygiene practices.
- Making appropriate use of safety resources provided onsite.
- Not attending the course if you are ill, actively experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or have recently been in close contact with someone who has tested positive or been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the exposure range currently identified by the CDC.
- Notifying ElectriCities staff if you test positive for COVID-19 up to 5 days after returning home, or in accordance with current contact tracing advice from federal and state health authorities.
