Highlight:

The **Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)** opened a series of grants related to brownfields including assessment coalition, community-wide assessment, multipurpose, revolving loan funds, and clean-up. EPA's Brownfields and Land Revitalization Program is designed to empower states, tribes, communities, and other stakeholders to work together to prevent, assess, safely clean up, and sustainably reuse brownfields. The deadline to apply to any of the FY23 grants, which are detailed in the table below, is November 22, 2022.

NEW -- The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) opened **Round 4 of the Reconnect Program** for high-speed internet on September 6, 2022. Funded through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), available funding includes up to \$150 million in loans, up to \$300 million in loan/grant combinations, and up to \$700 million in grants. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released the newly updated <u>State Energy and Environment Guide</u> <u>to Action</u> to help states design and implement policies that reduce emissions associated with electricity generation and energy consumption. The guide was first published in 2006 and last updated in 2015.
