On September 27, 2022, the U.S. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) approved the state of **North Carolina's EV Infrastructure Deployment Plan** which describes how the state intends to use its portion of the National EV Infrastructure (NEVI) formula program funds. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) opened **Round 4 of the Reconnect Program** for high-speed internet on September 6, 2022. Funded through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), available funding includes up to \$150 million in loans, up to \$300 million in loan/grant combinations, and up to \$700 million in grants. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Economic Development Administration (EDA) released a joint **resource guide to boost economic development in rural communities**.
