

## GRANTS ALERT for ElectriCities July 27, 2023

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## **Highlight:**

The Economic Development Administration (EDA) of the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) opened the \$200 million Distressed Area Recompete Pilot Grant Program (Recompete Pilot Program), with applications due by October 5, 2023. The Recompete Pilot Program, authorized as part of the CHIPS and Science Act (CHIPS Act) of 2022, "aims to alleviate persistent economic distress and support long-term, comprehensive economic development and job creation in places with a high prime-age (25 to 54 years) employment gap." For the purposes of the Recompete program, economic distress is determined by using prime-age employment gap (PAEG) data, specifically looking at places where prime-age workers have "stopped looking for jobs and left the labor force, as well as those who are currently looking for jobs and are unemployed." The program will be administered in two phases. Phase 1 applicants may apply for Strategy Development grants, approval of a Recompete Plan, or do both. Only selected Phase 1 awardees can apply in Phase 2 which will open after Phase 1 awardees are announced.

Notably, the Recompete grant comes with an Eligibility Mapping Tool which predetermines which communities fall within an eligible geography. Checking this resource is a critical first step in reviewing the grant for eligibility. A <u>YouTube video</u> provides instructions on how to use the mapping tool.

To further assist potential applicants, the EDA has developed a <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u>, and will host an additional webinar on the program on July 27 from 4 to 5 p.m. EST (register, <u>here</u>). This webinar will be recorded and posted to the <u>Recompete website</u>.

## Webinars, Blogs, Funding Guides and More:

**NEW** – The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is holding a stakeholder engagement effort on the **BRIC** (Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities) and Hazard Mitigation Assistance grant programs. **NEW** – The Grid Deployment Office of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) will host a webinar on the **National Transmission Planning Study**. The purpose of the study is to "identify transmission that will provide broad-scale, long-term benefits to electric customers, inform regional and interregional transmission planning processes, and identify interregional and national strategies to accelerate decarbonization while maintaining system reliability." The Joint Office of Energy and Transportation issued a new EV toolkit guide to help urban communities build out charging infrastructure. Called the "Charging Forward: A Toolkit for Planning and Funding Urban Electric Mobility Infrastructure," the guide provides information on how to scope, plan, and identify ways to leverage funding provided by the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) law. A companion toolkit is available for <u>rural communities</u>.

The <u>Southeast Crescent Regional Commission (SCRC)</u> has <u>extended the deadline</u> to submit a required pre-application for the new <u>State Economic and Infrastructure Development (SEID) grant</u> to <u>September 15</u>, 2023. Specific North Carolina communities are located within the SCRC footprint and have grant eligibility. More than \$4.4 million in funding has been allocated as North Carolina's share of the overall \$20 million in total funding.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Rural Development division developed an FAQ website specific to the Inflation Reduction Act and the new PACE (Powering Affordable Clean Energy) Program. The PACE loan program is for communities with less than 20,000 population. LOI's will be reviewed on *rolling basis*. Accepted LOIs will be invited to apply. LOIs are due by September 29, 2023.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) released a map "Energy Community Tax Credit Bonus," which can help communities understand their qualification status and the benefits they can expect from this tax credit for advancing clean energy initiatives.
