Webinars, Blogs, Funding Guides and More:

NEW (updated) -- The Economic Development Administration (EDA) of the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) released a Recompete Eligibility Mapping Tool and fact sheet in preparation for Distressed Area Recompete Pilot Program which opened on June 29, 2023. Additionally, two webinars have been scheduled, one on July 7 at Noon EST (register, here) and one July 11 at 4:30 p.m. EST (register, here). The Phase 1 application is due October 5, 2023.

NEW – The Energy Communities Interagency Working Group (IWG) of Coal and Power Plant Communities and Economic Revitalization will host a webinar in its series called "Overcoming Common Infrastructure Challenges in Energy Communities" on July 17 from 2 to 3:30 p.m. EST. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Rural Development division developed <u>an FAQ website specific to the Inflation Reduction Act and the new PACE (Powering Affordable Clean Energy) Program</u>. The <u>PACE loan program</u> is for communities with less than 20,000 population. Letters of Interest (LOI) are due by <u>September 29, 2023</u>.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (EERE) will host a webinar entitled "Stakeholder Engagement Keys to Success – Lessons Learned by Energy-Efficient Programs" on July 13 from 1 to 2:30 p.m. EST. Register, here.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) released a map "Energy Community Tax Credit Bonus," which can help communities understand their qualification status and the benefits they can expect from this tax credit for advancing clean energy initiatives. The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is offering more than \$22 million in cash prizes and technical assistance for winning ideas to accelerate widespread, equitable energy efficiency and building electrification upgrades. The **Buildings Upgrade Prize (Buildings UP)** was developed and funded by the **U.S. Department of Energy Building**

<u>Technologies Office</u> as part of its overall mission to reduce the carbon footprint of the U.S. building stock while maintaining or improving affordability, comfort, and performance. Phase 1 submissions are due <u>July 18, 2023</u>.

The U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) <u>Solar Power in Your Community Guidebook</u> serves as a resource to assist government officials and stakeholders in increasing deployment and local access to solar photovoltaics.

NEW -- The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will host a webinar on the **Solar for All grant competition** on July 12 from 1 to 3 p.m. EST. Register, <u>here</u>. The deadline to apply for a grant is **September 26**, 2023.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released an updated version (effective May 2023) of the <u>Power Resilience Guide for Water and Wastewater Utilities</u> for water utilities and electric providers. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released a Clean Water Act / National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) <u>Integrated Planning Toolkit for Permitting Authorities</u> assisting permitting authorities to review integrated plans and incorporate them into permits. Additionally, EPA is offering <u>free technical assistance</u> (TA) to municipalities and permitting authorities to support the integrated plan development and review process. <u>Learn more, and request TA</u>, here. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is hosting a webinar series for the 2023 Clean School Bus (CSB) grant program. Webinars will be held on a variety of topics through August 2023. More information and to register, here. The deadline to apply for a grant is August 22, 2023.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released an updated version of the <u>Greenhouse Gas Equivalencies</u> <u>Calculator</u>. Available in both Spanish and English, the calculator "translates emissions and energy data into real terms, like annual emissions from cars, homes, smartphones, or natural gas fired power plants." New, the calculator now "includes two options for electricity inputs: estimated emissions equivalencies based on electricity consumed or electricity use avoided. Previously, the Calculator provided estimates only for electricity avoided. By providing this choice, users will be able to access the appropriate emissions factor based on their need."
