Webinars, Blogs, Funding Guides and More:

The Economic Development Administration (EDA) of the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) offers **planning and local technical assistance** to cities, counties, local governments and others to "undertake and promote effective economic development programs through projects such as feasibility studies, impact analyses, disaster resiliency plans, and project planning." Applications are taken on a rolling basis. Learn more, <u>here</u>, for the Atlanta region which includes North Carolina.

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) published new <u>CFI Grant Program Questions and Answers (Q&A)</u> on May 5, 2023. The Q&A is a companion document to the CFI Program NOFO and provides additional information for potential applicants. More information on the CFI, <u>here.</u> The deadline to apply for a CFI grant has been extended to June 13, 2023.

Grants.gov will be down for maintenance from June 17-19, 2023.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Rural Development division developed <u>an FAQ website specific to</u> <u>the Inflation Reduction Act and the new PACE (Powering Affordable Clean Energy) Program</u>. The <u>PACE loan</u> <u>program</u> is for communities with less than 20,000 population. The application process opens June 30, 2023.

NEW (updated) – The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) will host the second of two webinars on the <u>new Renew</u> America's Nonprofits Grant program, which provides \$50 million to reduce carbon emissions, improve health and safety, and lower utilities costs at buildings owned and operated by 501(c)(3) nonprofits. The webinar is on June 8 at 3 p.m. EST (register, here). Additionally, Virtual Office Hours will be held on June 22 at 1 p.m. EST (register, here) and on July 13 at 1 p.m. EST (register, here). For nonprofits that wish to make energy efficient improvements to buildings they own (as a grant sub-recipient), the first step is to join the Teaming List. For organizations that want to be a prime recipient of the grant, an optional Letter of Intent (LOI) is due June 29, 2023; the full application is due August 3, 2023.

NEW (updated) -- The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) will host a webinar and a series of office hours on the **Buildings Upgrade Prize (Buildings UP)** which is open for Phase 1 applications currently but due by July 18, 2023. Review the Buildings UP timeline, including detailed information on upcoming webinars and office hours, <u>here</u>. The schedule is as follows: June 15 at 7:30 p.m. EST, July 6 at 3:30 p.m. EST, July 11 at 7:30 p.m. EST and July 13 at 12 p.m. EST.

With funding provided by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the International City/County Management Association (ICMA) and the Interstate Renewable Energy Council (IREC) are expanding the <u>SolSmart Designation</u> <u>Program</u> to include another 500 local governments. SolSmart provides no-cost technical assistance to help local governments and regional organizations meet solar energy best practices.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is offering more than \$22 million in cash prizes and technical assistance for winning ideas to accelerate widespread, equitable energy efficiency and building electrification upgrades. The **Buildings Upgrade Prize (Buildings UP)** was developed and funded by the **U.S. Department of Energy Building Technologies Office** as part of its overall mission to reduce the carbon footprint of the U.S. building stock while maintaining or improving affordability, comfort, and performance. Phase 1 submissions are due July 18, 2023.

The U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) <u>Solar Power in Your Community Guidebook</u> serves as a resource to assist government officials and stakeholders in increasing deployment and local access to solar photovoltaics.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) will host "office hours" on the new <u>Green and</u> <u>Resilient Retrofit Program (GRRP) for Multifamily Housing</u> every Wednesday, May 24 through June 28, 2023 from 3 to 4 p.m. EST. No registration necessary. <u>Join using this link</u>. The deadlines to apply to a series of three grants are March, April and May 2024.

NEW (updated) – The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released a Clean Water Act / National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) <u>Integrated Planning Toolkit for Permitting Authorities</u> assisting permitting authorities to review integrated plans and incorporate them into permits. Additionally, EPA is offering <u>free technical</u> <u>assistance (TA)</u> to municipalities and permitting authorities to support the integrated plan development and review process. <u>Learn more, and request TA</u>, here. The deadline to request TA is <u>August 31, 2023</u>.

NEW – The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will host a webinar on its <u>new Water Infrastructure</u> <u>Planning Tool called the Augmented Alternatives Analysis</u> and how it can help utilities engage community and "make cost-effective multi-benefit investments." The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released an updated version of the <u>Greenhouse Gas Equivalencies</u> <u>Calculator</u>. Available in both Spanish and English, the calculator "translates emissions and energy data into real terms, like annual emissions from cars, homes, smartphones, or natural gas fired power plants." New, the calculator now "includes two options for electricity inputs: estimated emissions equivalencies based on electricity consumed or electricity use avoided. Previously, the Calculator provided estimates only for electricity avoided. By providing this choice, users will be able to access the appropriate emissions factor based on their need."

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released a **Clean Energy Financing Toolkit for Decisionmakers**, which lists financing programs and policies by state and local governments and others that support investments in clean energy. Access the toolkit, <u>here</u>.
