Webinars, Blogs, Funding Guides and More:

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is holding a stakeholder engagement effort on the <u>BRIC</u> (<u>Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities</u>) and <u>Hazard Mitigation Assistance grant programs</u>. The Energy Communities Interagency Working Group (IWG) of Coal and Power Plant Communities and Economic Revitalization released the updated **eligibility maps for the 10% Bonus Tax Credit**. More information and to access the map, <u>here.</u>

The <u>Southeast Crescent Regional Commission (SCRC)</u> has *extended the deadline* to submit a required pre-application for the new <u>State Economic and Infrastructure Development (SEID) grant</u> to <u>September 15</u>, 2023. Specific North Carolina communities are located within the SCRC footprint and have grant eligibility. More than \$4.4 million in funding has been allocated as North Carolina's share of the overall \$20 million in total funding.

NEW -- The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the U.S. Department of Treasury, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Economic Development Agency (EDA), released **two new pocket guides to assist rural stakeholders** identify funding opportunities (many provided by the Inflation Reduction Act) for workforce, climate-smart and resiliency investments. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Rural Development division developed <u>an FAQ website specific to the Inflation Reduction Act and the new PACE (Powering Affordable Clean Energy) Program</u>. The <u>PACE loan program</u> is for communities with less than 20,000 population. LOI's will be reviewed on *rolling basis*. Accepted LOIs will be invited to apply. LOIs are due by <u>September 29, 2023</u>.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) released a map "Energy Community Tax Credit Bonus," which can help communities understand their qualification status and the benefits they can expect from this tax credit for advancing clean energy initiatives. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is holding a week-long "fair" of virtual events for local governments to prepare to leverage federal funding opportunities as they develop climate action plans that are required under **EPA's Climate Pollution Reduction Grant program**.
