Webinars, Blogs, Funding Guides and More:

The Energy Communities Interagency Working Group (IWG) of Coal and Power Plant Communities and Economic Revitalization released the updated **eligibility maps for the 10% Bonus Tax Credit**. More information and to access the map, <u>here.</u>

The NC Department of Information Technology (NCDIT) is seeking information from stakeholders statewide on what North Carolinians need to access and afford high-speed internet. Two surveys, which will inform the state's Digital Equity Plan, are available; they are the Digital Equity Survey and the Asset Inventory Survey. More information and to access the surveys, here. The deadline to respond is August 31, 2023.

The <u>Southeast Crescent Regional Commission (SCRC)</u> has extended the deadline to submit a required pre-application for the new <u>State Economic and Infrastructure Development (SEID) grant</u> to <u>September 15</u>, 2023. Specific North Carolina communities are located within the SCRC footprint and have grant eligibility. More than \$4.4 million in funding has been allocated as North Carolina's share of the overall \$20 million in total funding.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Rural Development division developed an FAQ website specific to the Inflation Reduction Act and the new PACE (Powering Affordable Clean Energy) Program. The PACE loan program is for communities with less than 20,000 population. LOI's will be reviewed on rolling basis. Accepted LOIs will be invited to apply. LOIs are due by September 29, 2023.

NEW—The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) launched the <u>Community Energy Innovation Prize</u> that will award up to \$7.5 million in cash prizes to organizations "supporting innovation, entrepreneurship, capacity building, and economic development in communities historically underrepresented in climate and energy technology funding." The Community Energy Innovation Prize is the successor to the Inclusive Energy Innovation Prize and the Community Clean Energy Coalition Prize. This new Prize has three separate tracks, <u>each will different deadlines</u>. An introductory webinar on the Community and Manufacturing Ecosystem tracks will be held on <u>October 10 at 3 p.m. EST</u>. Register, here.

NEW—The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) will host a webinar on the **Capacity Building for Repurposing Energy Assets initiative** on **September 7 from 2 to 3 p.m. EST**. Register, <u>here</u>. The initiative, due to open in September, will "assist communities where a significant portion of their local economy has historically been supported by energy assets, such as coal, oil, and/or natural gas power facilities and accompanying equipment and infrastructure."

NEW – The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) will host a webinar on the <u>Transmission Siting and Economic</u>

Development grant on September 14 at 2 p.m. EST. Register, <u>here</u>. The deadline to submit a concept paper is October 31, 2023. Full applications are due April 5, 2024.

NEW—The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) launched the Advanced Cybersecurity Technology (ACT) 1 Prize competition which is part of the Rural and Municipal Utility Cybersecurity (RMUC) Program. This program will provide \$250 M over five years to "enhance the cybersecurity posture of cooperative, municipal, and small investorowned electric utilities." The \$8.96 M ACT 1 Prize is the first in a series of prizes from the RMUC program. Applications are due November 29, 2023.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) released a map "Energy Community Tax Credit Bonus," which can help communities understand their qualification status and the benefits they can expect from this tax credit for advancing

The U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) is hosting "office hours" for the new <u>Distressed Area</u> <u>Recompete Pilot (Recompete)</u> grant program, which has an <u>October 5</u>, 2023 deadline to apply. They are:

NEW -- The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Department of the Army will host a webinar on September 12th on the <u>final rule related to the recent Supreme Court decision in Sackett v.
