## Webinars, Blogs, Funding Guides and More:

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) is seeking public input on ways it can <u>simply the management and administration of prepardedness grant programs</u>. Submit comments by 5 p.m. November 7, 2023, <u>here</u> or by <u>emailing here</u>.

**NEW** – The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will host a webinar on the **Electric Vehicle (EV) Charger Reliability and Accessibility Accelerator NOFO** on September 21 from 3 to 4 p.m. EST. Register, <u>here</u>. The deadline to apply for a grant is November 13, 2023.

Grants.gov will be down for maintenance October 21-23, 2023.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Rural Development division developed <u>an FAQ website specific to</u> <u>the Inflation Reduction Act and the new PACE (Powering Affordable Clean Energy) Program.</u> The <u>PACE loan</u> <u>program</u> is for communities with less than 20,000 population. LOI's will be reviewed on rolling basis. Accepted LOIs will be invited to apply. LOIs are due by September 29, 2023.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) launched the <u>Community Energy Innovation Prize</u> that will award up to \$7.5 million in cash prizes to organizations "supporting innovation, entrepreneurship, capacity building, and economic development in communities historically underrepresented in climate and energy technology funding." The Community Energy Innovation Prize is the successor to the Inclusive Energy Innovation Prize and the Community Clean Energy Coalition Prize. This new Prize has three separate tracks, <u>each will different deadlines</u>. An introductory webinar on the Community and Manufacturing Ecosystem tracks will be held on October 10 at 3 p.m. EST. Register, <u>here</u>.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) launched the <u>Advanced Cybersecurity Technology (ACT) 1 Prize competition</u> which is part of the Rural and Municipal Utility Cybersecurity (RMUC) Program. This program will provide \$250 M over five years to "enhance the cybersecurity posture of cooperative, municipal, and small investor-owned electric utilities." The \$8.96 M ACT 1 Prize is the first in a series of prizes from the RMUC program. Applications are due November 29, 2023.

The U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) is hosting "office hours" for the new <u>Distressed Area</u> <u>Recompete Pilot (Recompete)</u> grant program, which has an October 5, 2023 deadline to apply. Wed., October 4 from 4 to 5 p.m. EST; register, here.

**NEW** -- The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) updated its website page that provides an <u>overview of</u> <u>current and upcoming funding opportunities from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Act (BIL) and the Inflation</u> <u>Reduction Act (IRA).</u> The information is current as of <u>September 8, 2023</u>.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released a <u>new guide</u> as part of its <u>Climate Pollution Reduction</u> <u>Grants (CPRG) program</u>. The guide outlines funding opportunities for local governments (and others) for the development of climate action plans under the CPRG. Note, the second phase NOFO's of the CPRG program (implementation phase funded at \$4.6 billion) will be released in September 2023. A webinar on an update of the next phase of the Climate Pollution Reduction Grants program will be held September 21 at 2:30 p.m. EST. Register, <u>here</u>.

**NEW** – The White House released "Investing in America" Technical Assistance (TA) Guide, which details TA available through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) and the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA). TA in this resource is defined as "as programs, processes, and resources that provide targeted support to a community, region, organization, or other beneficiary to help them access and deploy federal funding."

## **Recorded Webinars and Other:**

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has a series of pre-recorded videos on the new <u>Green and Resilient Retrofit Program (GRRP)</u> cohort of three grants (Elements, Leading Edge, and Comprehensive), plus accompanying fact sheets. Go to the main GRRP website to access the information, <u>here</u>. The deadlines to apply are rolling through March, April and May 2024, respectively for the three grants.
